In the name of God, Amen.

I, William A. Arnsparger of near Sabillasville, in the County of Frederick and State of Maryland, being of sound mind and memory, and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life, do therefore make, ordain, publish and declare, this to be my last will and Testament!

FIRST. order and direct that my executor hereinafter named pay all my just debts and funeral expenses as soon after my decease as conveniently may be.

SECOND. after the payment of such funeral expenses and debts, I give devise and bequeath to my wife, Annie R. Arnsparger, my house and lot in the town of Sabillasville, Frederick County, Maryland, known as Lot No. 21 on the Plat of Sabillasville, on file in the office of Circuit Court for Frederick County, to be hers until her death, and to be then sold and divided equally among my five children hereinafter named, share and share alike.

THIRD. I order and direct that all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal and mixed, shall be divided equally among my children, Nora M. Chenoweth, Russell W. Arnsparger, Ruth A. Arnsparger, Lloyd A. Arnsparger, Catherine J. Arnsparger, and my wife Annie R. Arnsparger share and share alike.
