Hurley of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland Witnesseth, that in consideration of One Hundred Dollars, the said John E. Hurley and wife do grant unto Hiram Stottlemeyer of said County, all that lot or parcel of land, situated in said County, the same being part of a tract of land called "Stony Bagger Enlarged" Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed, at a point in the public road, at the end of 7 8/20 ps, on the 6th line of the whole tract and running thence with the outlines thereof N. 70° W, 86 12/20 Ps. S. 29° W. 40 Ps, S. 87 W. 10 Ps, S. 4.2 Ps. then S, 66° E. 52 ps, to a stone planted at the end of the 3rd line of a deed from said John E. Hurley & wife, to Moses L. Hurley, and with said deed three courses and distances N. 27° E. to within 12 feet of the end of 48 perches, on said 6th line then parallel with said 6th line, S. 70° E. 40 12/20 ps to the Public Road then N. 27° E. 12 Feet to the place of beginning containing 13 1/8 acres of land more or less.
