The petition of the Real Estate and Improvement Company of Baltimore City, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, respectfully shows unto Your Honors:-

1st. That on the 16th day of August, in the year 1913, William M. Barker and Ada V. Barker, his wife, executed to petitioner their deed of mortgage, to secure payment of an indebtedness of Seven Hundred and Fifty-one Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$751.00 due petitioner; which said mortgage is recorded in Liber H.W.B. No. 305, Folio 503 to one of the Land Records of Frederick County; a certified copy of which is herewith filed as Exhibit "A" to this petition, and which, together with all other exhibits herewith produced, it is prayed may be taken and considered as part of this petition.

2d. That the said mortgage covered all that lot, piece or parcel of ground and premises situate, lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, which is described as Lot No. 4, in Block No. 16, on the Real Estate and Improvement Company's Sub-division of part of Brunswick, Maryland; said lot being further described as follows:- Beginning at the South East corner of "A" Street, and the fifteen (15) foot alley first East of Seventh Avenue; and running thence Easterly along the South side of "A" Street fifty (50) feet; thence Southerly parallel to Seventh Avenue, one hundred and fifty (150) feet to the North side of a fifteen (15) foot
