Whereas I Zachariah G. Harris of Frederick County in the State of Maryland am desirous of adding to the provisions of my last will and testament dated on the Second day of July in the year Eighteen hundred and Seventy two, do hereby make this codicil thereto, as follows: I direct my Executors of my said Will to run out a divisional line through my Eighty six acre tract as follows: Beginning at the South side of Bennett Creek, at a bunch of Maples standing about three feet from my line and running thence Northwardly across said Creek to a marked Sycamore tree; thence still Northwardly to a marked Marsh Willow tree; then Northwardly to a marked locust tree standing on the East side of a little branch; thence Northwardly to another marked locust tree; then across said branch to the West side thereof and then in a straight line to where the public road crosses Gardner's spring branch; and all of my land lying on the East side of said divisional line and enclosed within the outlines of my said 86 acre tract. I give and devise to my son, John P. Harris in trust to hold the same and to allow my son, Joseph C. D. Harris and his present wife, Rachel to use, occupy and enjoy the same and the rents, proceeds and income thereof for and during their joint lives and for and during the life of the survivor of them and especially so that their interests therein and said rents, proceeds or income shall not become liable for the debts of them or either of them or subject to any disposition by them or either of them or to be taken in execution of attachment or otherwise howsoever; and upon the death of the said Joseph C. D. Harris and his said wife, then to hold the same in like trusts for the benefit of their children, Ada Harris, Emma Harris, Nellie Harris and Alense Harris until the youngest of said children shall arrive at the age of twenty one years; and then immediately the said trust shall cease and said land shall become the property of said Ada, Emma, Nellie and Alense Harris absolutely.

I hereby direct my said Executors to sell the thirty-seven (37) acres which I bought of Albert Miler together with my home farm and as part of it; but the balance of my 86 acre tract, after deducting so much thereof as is disposed of in this Codicil, they may sell either with the home farm or separately as they may deem best.
