Said testator also left a nephew, the present witness who is married to Katherine E. Keefer, both of whom are adults residing in Frederick Md, All of the parties to these proceedings are adults excepting the defendant Frank H. Keefer.

The said real estate is not susceptible or partition or division among the parties entitled thereto without great loss and injury, and the only way to make a division of the interest among the parties interested therein is by a sale of the property and a division of the proceeds among them, and it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties especially the infant for the property to be sold and the proceeds divided among them.

Nannie C. Carty, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn and examined viva voce deposes and says as follows:-

My name is Nannie C. Carty, I am the widow of Clarence C. Carty, my age is 62 years and I reside in Frederick City, Maryland and know all the parties to this suit, I am a niece of Harry C. Keefer the testator mentioned in these proceedings.

Mrs. Margaret H. Keefer the widow of the said Harry C. Keefer died in Frederick, Md, on or about November 28, 1918.

At the time of his death the said Harry C. Keefer was seized on a House and Lot situated on the North side of West Third Street in Frederick, Frederick County, Maryland, being the same which was conveyed to him by the deed of which Exhibit B. filed with this Bill in this case is a certified copy.

Hiram M. Keefer, a brother of the said testator was my father, and died December 15, 1904, intestate, His widow, my mother, Margaret A. C. Keefer died March 17, 1917, Hiram M. Keefer left the following children as his heirs at law; viz:- Nannie C. Carty (the present witness) and another daughter Cora M. Keefer who is unmarried; both of whom are adults, and a son Charles W. H. Keefer who is dead and who left surviving him a widow Stella C. Keefer, who has since intermarried with H. B. Dertzbaugh, both of whom reside in Washington, D. C. The said Charles W. H. Keefer also died intestate leaving surviving him a son, Frank H. Keefer who is under 21 years of age, but whose now married to the defendant Blanche Keefer, both of whom are non-residents of this State.

Keefer who has since died and leaving surviving him as his heirs at law William E. Keefer and Virginia McRea Keefer, both adults and unmarried, residing in Washington, D. C. and a son James J. Keefer who is married to Elizabeth B. Keefer, who are adults residing in New York City, N. Y.
