THIS INDENTURE, made the 23rd, day of March in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Four. Between the Pennsylvania College of Gettysburg in the County of Adams, a corporation chartered under the laws of the Commonwealth, of Pennsylvania, of the first part, and J. Wesley Creager, of Frederick County, Maryland, of the second part;

WITNESSETH, that the said Trustees of Pennsylvania College, of Gettysburg in the County of Adams, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Thousand dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, unto it well and truly paid, by the said J. Wesley Creager, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted bargained and sold, aliened and enfeoffed, released and confirmed and by these presents does grant bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release and confirm unto the said J. Wesley Creager his heirs and assigns, all that tract of land situated in Frederick County, Maryland, bounded and described, as follows:- Beginning at a point on the west side of the Frederick and emmitsburg turnpike road, at a corner of Charles A. Damuth's land and running thence North fifty-eight degrees west, Forty five and sixty-eight one hundredths perches; North Forty One and one half degrees west, fifty four perches, to the middle of the public road; North Six degrees, west, Forty and eight tenths perches, with middle of said public road,; North Fifty Nine and One fourth degrees, west thirty eight perches; north Sixteen degrees west, thirteen perches, to Hickory-Tree; north Twenty-Two and one half degrees, East Eighteen and eight-tenths perches North Fifty-Seven and One -half degrees, east, Twenty perches.
