This Deed made this Twenty Ninth day of June, in the year eighteen hundred and Ninety Two By Frederick White, and Susan White, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, WITNESSETH; that in consideration of Two hundred and fifty dollars, the Frederick White and Susan White his wife, do grant unto J. Wesley Creeger, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, all these two lots and parcels of Land Situated in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, which are described as follows,

BEGINNING for lot No. 6, at a stone pile, at the end of a line drawn S, $31\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W, 60, 2, perches from stone planted on west side of a tract of land owned by Frederick White, obtained by him from Josiah G. Mesner and wife, by deed dated Nov, II, 1868 and recorded in Liber C, m. No. 2, folio 501, &c., it being the stone of beginning of said tract, and running thence $31\frac{1}{2}$ degrees, West 18, 5, perches, thence $77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ west 14 1/4, 5 perches, to division line, and stone pile, thence 11° E, 17, 3, perches to a stone pile, thence 78° e, 152 perches, to beginning containing sixteen Acres of land, more or less, Also lot No. 7, beginning at a stone pile, at the end of a line drawn, S, $31\frac{1}{2}$, w, 78, perches, from a stone planted on the West side of a tract of land owned by Frederick Whit, as described in lot No. 6, it being the stone of Beginning, of said tract, and running south, $31\frac{1}{2}$ W, 22, 25, perches, to Joseph Mesner's Corner stone, and with said Mesner's line, N, 77° , W, 36, perches, to beginning.
