THIS DEED made this 27th, day of April, A. D. 1899, by Michael Wachter and Ann Rebecca Wachter, his wife of Frederick County, Maryland,

WITNESSETH. that for and in consideration of the sum of Two-hundred dollars, the said Michael Wachter and Ann Rebecca Wachter his wife; do grant in fee simple, unto J. W. Greager, of Frederick county, Maryland, all of the following parcel or part of a tract of land, called the mountain tract known and designated on the plat of said tract as lot No 3. BEGINNING for the same at a stake. standing at the end of the third line, of lot No.2. and with said line reversed, South ten and a half degrees, west. forty one and eight tenths, perches North Seventy Nine and a half degrees west fifty two and eight tenths perches. North ten and a half degrees, east forty two and eight tenths perches to intersect the third line, of the Deed from John Mephorson. to F.A.
