WITNESSETH, That in consideration of One hundred and fifty (\$150.) dollars, the said James W, Baltzell. and Mary A, Baltzell his wife, do grant in fee simple. unto J, Wesley Creager the following Mountain lot situated about one mile north of Thurment, frederick County, Maryland,

BEGINNING FOR THE SAME, at the North West Corner of division No, 32, and running North Sixty Nine degrees, West, one hundred and four perches, south Twenty degrees, west Twenty eight and One half perches, South, Seventy three degrees, east One hundred and four perches, thence North, twenty degrees twenty five perches, to the place of beginning, containing seventeen acres of land more or less, it being the land designated as lot No Thirty Three in the plat filed in No. 5918.
