No. REQUEST.

This deed made this Seventh day of May, in the year Nineteen hundred by us Merritt S. Haines and Leila A. Haines, his wife. Moses Whitson and Mary C. Whitson. his wife. of Washington County Maryland. and Mary E. Haines of Baltimore City, Maryland, Witnesseth; that in consideration of the sum of thirty Eight Hundred and Sixty dollars. the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we the said Merritt, S. Haines, and Leila A. Haines. his wife. Moses whitman and Mary C, Whitson wife. and Mary E, Haines, do grant unto John Wesley Creager of Frederick County, Maryland. in fee simple. all the following described tracts. or parcels of land, situate, lying and being in Washington County, Maryland. the first part being a tract of land called Park Head Amended and beginning at stone pile satnding at the end of Sixty five perches in the first line of a deed from George C. Chambers and others, to I,B,Haines and others, dated the 2nd day of April 1867, it being also the end of the first line of a deed from Merritt S. Haines. and others to Lewis Weible. dated the 19th. day of April A.D. 1896, and running thence with the first line of the first mentioned Deed, west 28 perches, to a Black Oak tree, then with part of the Second line of the first mentioned deed, South 62° E. 42 1/4 ps, to a stone then leaving the outlines of the first mentioned, deed, South 80 1/2 ° W. 10 ps, s. 4. ° 4 ps, S, 75 1/4 °, W, 10, ps, to black oak sapling N. 34 1/2 ° W, 106, ps, to Gum tree, S. 52° W, 60 1/2 ps, to an oak, tree, N. 30° W, 85 perches, to intersect the thirty first N. 50° e. 565, ps. line to the first mentioned deed, and with it N. 50° E. 227, ps, to the land of Lewis H.
