THIS DEED made this 15th day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy by us Lewis E, Derr, and his wife, Ann R,c.Derr, of Frederick County, and state of Maryland,

WITNESSETH; that in consideration of hundred and eighty eight and seventy five cents (~~288.75,~~), we the said Lewis e, Derr and Ann r, C, Derr do grant unto Jehn Derr, and Jehn f. fleek of Frederick County, aforesaid, all the following described lot of ground, situated in Frederick County, and being part, of a tract of land called "Geel Spring". Beginning for the last or lot of ground, hereby intended to be conveyed, at the end of 24 1/2 perches on the first line of lot No. 12, as laid out for Peter Schlessor on the 28th day of march 1867, and running thence south 31°, W, 20 ps, to a heap of stones, thence 81° East 60 3/4 perches, to a large stone, thence North 1 degree east 14 ps, thence North 73 1/4, degrees east 52 perches, to the Beginning, Containing 5 1/2 Acres of land more or less, in fee simple. Being part of the deed from Jehn Schlessor and wife to the said Lewis E. derr, dated on the 31st day of March 1870,
