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To the Honorable, the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as
A Court of Equity,

The Bill of Complaint of Annie I. Bowers, Clara Elizabeth Ordeman, Herman Ordeman, her husband, Viola R. Bowers, William D. Bowers. and Harry Hubert Bowers, respectfully Shows, unto your Honors;-

1st. That Harry W. Bowers, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, departed this life, leaving a 1st Will and Testament, bearing date on the 22nd. day of May, 1913, duly Pro-
ated, and admitted to Record and recorded in Liber S,D,t, No,2, folio 522, one of the Record
Books, for wills in the Office of the Register of Wills, for Frederick County, by the provisions
of which among other devises and bequests, he did give and bequeath to his wife, the said Annie
I. Bowers, one of the above complainants, so long as she should remain his widow, all of his
property, real personal and mixed. and at her death did direct that his estate should be equally
divided among his four Children, the said Clara Elizabeth Ordeman wife of Herman Ordeman, Viola
R. Bowers, William D. Bowers, And Harry Hubert Bowers, upon such terms and with such conditions
and limitations as his wife Anna I. Bowers, by her last will shall direct; and did further in the
event of the death of his said wife, without leaving a last will, or in the event of her re-marr-
iage, then give and bequeath his entire estate to his four Children, above named to be equally
divided among them, Share and Share alike; and in the event of the death of any of his said
children before final distribution without leaving Child or children living did give, devise
and bequeath the share or portion of such child to be divided equally among his children living
at the time of such final distribution, and upon the condition above named or set forth; and in
the event of the death of any of his said Children, leaving child or children living at the time
of final distribution, did give devise and bequeath the share or portion of such deceased parent
to the child or children at the time of final distribution, to be equally divided between them
share and share alike, and did further provide in the event either his son William D. Bowers or
his Son, Harry Hubert Bowers. or both of them, should be desirous to go into business and need
capital therefor, said wife should have the power, should she see fit, to advance to either, or
both of them, a sum of money for that purpose, not to exceed one-eighth of his entire estate, in
either case; and that such money so paid them should be considered an advancement of part of the
ir share, of his estate, to be deducted from their portion of final distribution, And did desire
his wife, during her life time to keep the house where I now reside, as a home for my unmarried
children. Then after empowering his executrix to sell any and all of his real estate " should
the necessity arise " did lastly constitute and appoint his wife, the said Anna I Bowers, Execu-
trix of his said last will and testament. all of which will fully appear by reference to a cer-
tified Copy of his said last will herewith filed as "exhibit" A, it is prayed may be taken and
considered as part of this Bill of Complaint,

2nd, That a portion of the real Estate of whio the said Harry W. Bowers died seized and
possessed, consists of a house and lot of ground situate and being on the East side of South
Market Street in Frederick City, Frederick County, State of Maryland being the real estate Con-
veyed unto him by Richard P. Stern and wife, by deed bearing date on the 29th, day of March .
1915, recorded in Liber H.W.B. No,312, folio 237. one of the Land Records of Frederick County.
