To the Honorable The Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County,
Sitting as a Court of Equity,

The Bill of Complainant of The Citizens Saving Bank of Thurmont Frederick County, Maryland, a body corporate, who sues on behalf of itself as well as all the other Creditors, of Emma E, Unger, late of Frederick County, deceased, who may come in and contribute to the expense of these proceedings, respectfully, shows unto your Honors,

1. That Emma E, Unger, late of Frederick County, but now deceased, was during her life time and at the time of her death, indebted unto the complainant upon her promissory note, dated (June 15, 1918,) in the sum of \$100.00, payable to this Complainant six(6) months after date, with a credit on said promissory note, under date of July, fifteenth, Nineteen Hundred and Eighteen (July 19, 1918) of one dollar, twenty cents, leaving a balance to this complainant of Ninety Eight dollars and eighty cents, (\$98.80) as is fully shown by said promissory note, filed herewith as part of this Bill, of Complaint. marked Exhibit No.1. which together all other Exhibits are, and after filed, it is prayed may be taken and considered as part of this Bill of Complaint.

2, That the said Emma Unger, being indebted unto the complainant, as aforesaid was likewise further indebted unto this complainant, in the sum of One hundred and fifteen dollars, (\$115.00). on her promissory note, dated October 27th, 1915 with accrued interest, from April 27th, 1918, which said promissory Note, was secured by a deed of Mortgage, executed by the said Emma G, Unger, conveying said real estate in Thurmont, Frederick County, Maryland, said promissory note, being filed herewith, marked Exhibit, No.2. and a certified Copy of said Mortgage, securing the payment of said note, being filed herewith marked Exhibit No.3. to this Bill,

3, That the said Emma E Unger departed this life on September 28th, 1918, intestate, and who was seized and possessed of a house and Lot, Situated in Thurmont, Frederick County, Maryland, having been conveyed to her by deed, from John D; Unger. dated October 29th, 1911, and is recorded in Liber H,W,B, No.298. folio. 137, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, a certified Copy of said deed, being filed herewith marked exhibit, No,4. to the Bill of Complaint.

4, That the said Emma F, Unger, having died intestate, as aforesaid, left no personal Property, with which to pay the claim, of this complainant, and of the other Creditors of the deceased,

5, That the said Emma F, Unger left surviving her, as her only heirs at law the following named children to wit:- John Russell Young, a son whose wife's name is Mary Root Unger, Lester A, Unger, a son whose wife's name is Gertrude Sweeney, Unger, Beatrice Gaugh a daughter, whose husband' name is Charles Gaugh,

6, That since the death of the said Emma E, Unger, the daughter Beatrice Gaugh, mentioned in the aforesaid paragraph, departed this life on October 7, 1918, she leaving surviving her, her husband, Charles Gaugh, and two children under the age of twenty-one years, whose names are Mary Gaugh and John Gaugh,
