Hereof Fail you not as you will answer the contrary at your Peril,

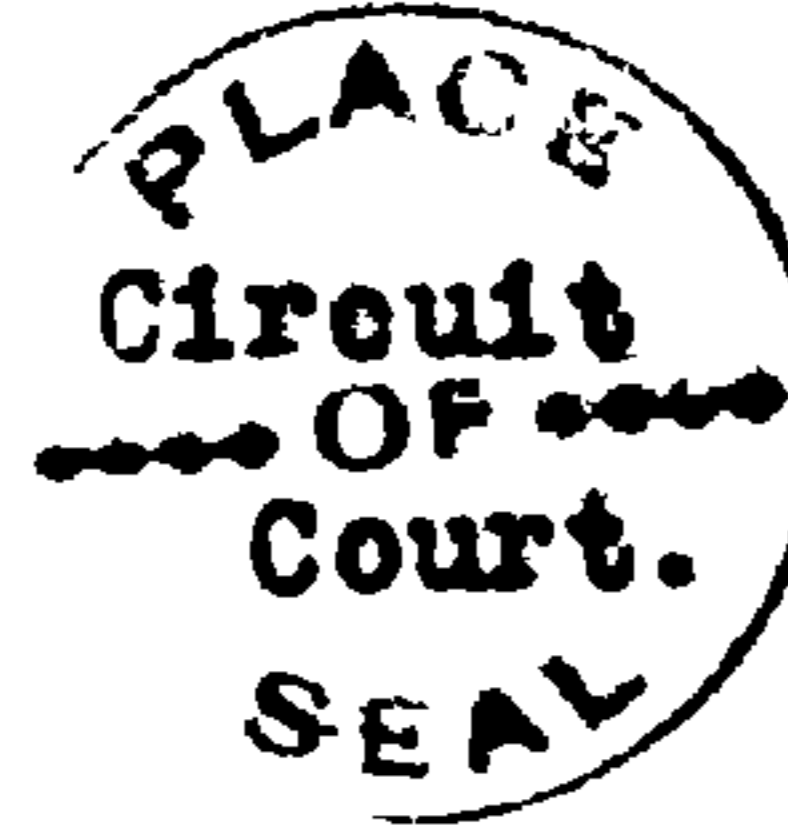
