Mehrling in the sum of \$500.00 said Single Bill being dated August 10-1907, and upon his Single Bill with Sadie E Mehrling, in the sum of One thousand Dollars, said single Bill being dated, October 8th-1907, and upon his single Bill of J.R. Wise, payable to Harry L. Mehrling. and endorsed by him, unto the said Savings Bank of Brunswick, Maryland in the sum of \$200.00 said Single Bill being dated January-6th-1908, and upon his single Bill being dated March 12th-1908. with Sadie E. Mehrling in the sum of \$270.00, said single Bill being dated, March 12th 1908, and upon his single Bill with Sadie E. Mehrling. in the sum of Fourteen Hundred (\$1400.00) said single Bill being dated, April 8th-1909, and upon his Single Bill payable to Roy B.
