In Pursuance of the Annexed order of the Court, and Notice given me by the Solicitor for The Plaintiff, in the Above entitled cause, I Clayton O. Keedy, one of the regular Examiners of said Court, duly appointed, qualified and sworn, having assigned the first day of May, 1911, at my office, in Frederick City, as the time and place for taking the testimony in this Cause, and having given due notice, thereof to the parties, concerned, did at the time and place, proceed to take the following depositions, to wit:-

The Plaintiff filed with the Examiner as evidence Exhibit A, B, C, and D, also exhibit Nos. 1 to 10, inclusive which are herewith returned by the said Examiner -----

Sadie E. Mehrling, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Plaintiff, being duly sworn and examined viva-voce, deposes and says as follows --

My name is Sadie E. Mehrling, my age is 36- years, I reside in Brunswick, and am the widow of Harry L. Mehrling, died at his home in Brunswick, Frederick County - Maryland in June 11- 1910, and left no will, as his widow, and an only child Nellie Louise MEhrling as his only heir at law the said Child will be 14- years of age on the 31st- of May- 1911, and makes her home with me.

The said Harry L. Mehrling left no personal property at all, and there was no administration on his estate, and he died without leaving a will,

the said Harry L. Mehrling at the time of his death was seized and possessed of a number of Pieces of real estate, all located in Brunswick Frederick County, Maryland, and which are described in Exhibit A, B, C. and D, Filed, with the Bill of Complaint,

The said Harry L. Mehrling was at the time of his death indebted to the Savings Bank of Brunswick, Md, on ten single Bills, Vis:-

- 1 dated Jan- 6- 1908- 6 mths for 200,- signed by J. R. Wenner and Harry L. Mehrling, Payable to Harry L. Mehrling. and endorsed by him to the said Savings Bank of Brunswick,
- 1- dated March 12- 1908. at 6 mths, for \$270, 00 signed by Harry L. Mehrling and Sadie E. Mehrling,
