The Bill of Complaint of Thomas P, Rice, George A, Rice, Amy A, Rice, Perry B. Rice, and Irvin L, Rice, by Oris B, Rice his mother and next friend, and Oris B, Rice, respectfully shows unto your Honors;-

1st- that the said Thomas P, Rice and his Brother, David S, Rice, late of Baltimore City, deceased, were owners, and Tenants in Common of a lot of ground, Situate lying and being in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, Beginning for the same at the North east Corner of lot heretofore conveyed, by John W, Payne, unto Albert T, Rice, by deed dated the second day of July, in the year, 1884, and binding on east Fifth Street, westwardly, thirty Three feet, ten inches, more or less, then southwardly, and parallel with Middle Alley, two Hundred feet more or less, until it intersects, the North West Corner, of the lot conveyed, to David S, Rice, then eastwardly, binding on the division line of the lot hereby conveyed, and the lots conveyed to David S, Rice, and to Lewis A, Rice, Thirty Three feet, ten inches, to intersect the North East corner of the lot conveyed to Lewis A Rice, then Northwardly, and parallel to Chappel alley, Two Hundred feet more or less, to the place of Beginning, and being the same real estate conveyed to the said Thomas P, Rice, and David S, Rice, as tenants in Common by deed dated the 21st; day, February A, D, 1901, and recorded in Liber D, H, H, No. 7. folio 705, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, as will appear by reference to said Deed here with filed, Marked Exhibit "A" and which together with all other exhibits, herein after produced, it is prayed may be taken and considered as part of this Bill of complaint,
