ORDER OF PUBLICATION.

William B, Grimes and Others vs, William G, Grimes, Mortgagee, and Mabel I, Grimes,

No, 9969-Equity, The object of this suit is to procure a decree, for the sale of certain real estate, situated in Frederick County, Maryland of which William B, Grimes, and Annie I Grimes, respectively died seized and possessed,

the bill states that on December 7th, 1913, William B, Grimes died, intestate, seized of certain Real estate, which is particularly described, in said Bill and that on March 14th- 1919, Annie I, Grimes his Widow, Died, intestate seized and possessed, of certain other real estate which is particularly described in said Bill, and that they left surviving them the same Heirs at law, all of whom are adults, to whom the said real estate descended, as Tenants in common, as follows a son William G, Grimes, whose wife's name is Mabel I Grimes a son Marshall E Grimes, whose wife's name is Sarah E, Grimes, and a son John H, Grimes, All of whom reside in Baltimore City, Maryland, Excepting Mabel I Grimes who is a Non-resident of the State of Maryland, a son Francis E, Grimes whose wife's name is Florence Grimes, a son Joseph H. Grimes, whose wife's name is Nora Grimes, a son Oscar B, Grimes, whose wife's name is Martha Grimes, all of whom reside in Carroll County, Maryland, A daughter Belva I Shearer, whose husband's name is Ersie I, Shearer, and a son James E, Grimes, whose wife's name is Ethel Grimes, all of whom reside in Frederick County, Maryland, that all of said parties are plaintiffs, in said County, that all the parties are plaintiffs, in said cause except, Mabel I Grimes, who with William G, Grimes, Mortgagee are Defendants, that Annie L, Grimes in her life-time executed a Mortgage, on certain portions of her said real estate described therein, to the said William G, Grimes, upon which said Mortgage there is an unpaid, balance due, of \$1500.00 with interest from April 1st- 1919, that said real estate is not susceptible of Partition, or division amongst the parties entitled therein, without great loss and injury, to them and it would be to the best interests and advantage of all the parties, interested, to sell said real estate under a decree of the Court, and after the payment of said Mortgage, debt, interest, costs, and expenses, to divide the proceeds amongst the parties entitled thereto,

It is thereupon this 16th day of July 1919, ordered by the Circuit Court of Frederick County, in Equity, that the Plaintiffs by causing a copy of this order to be inserted, in some newspaper published in said Frederick County, once in each of four successive weeks, before the 14th day of August, 1919, give notice to the said absent Defendant, of the Object and Substance, of this Bill, warning her to appear in this court in person or by Solicitor, on or before the 30th day of August, next, to show cause if any they have, why a decree ought not to be passed, as prayed,
