The petition of Maude M. Halley, of Washington D.C, respectfully shows unto your Honors,
1st;- That your Oratrix is a part Defendant to this cause and is the widow, of Edward
M. Halley, deceased, and the mother of all the other parties, to this cause, both plaintiff,
and Defendant,

2nd- That since the filing of the Bill of Complaint, one of the infant Defendants, to wit.
Nan- Castle Halley, has Married, and that the other infant defendants, to wit. Edward M. Halley,
Jr., David A. Halley, and Frank M. Halley are under age, of twenty one years, and no
person has been appointed the legal Guardian for said Infants,

3rd, That Your Oratrix has had care and custody of the said infants, since the decease, of
Edward M. Halley, their father, and your Oratrix is the Mother and the Natural Guardian of
said infants, children of your Oratrix, and the said Edward M. Halley, Your Oratrix late
husband,

Your Oratrix therefore prays the Court that your oratrix may be by Order and decree of
your Honorable Court duly appointed the guardian of the said infant Defendants, in this
cause, to wit;- Edward M. Halley Jr., David A. Halley, and Frank M. Halley, with such terms
and conditions, as your Honors may impose for Your Oratrix faithful administration of her
said Guardianship,

the foregoing petition of Maude M. Halley, Mother of said infant Defendants, Edward M,
Halley Jr., David A. Halley, and Frank M. Halley, asking for the petitioners appointment
as Guardian of the said Infants, Defendants, Having been submitted, to the Court, and by
the Court read and considered, It is thereupon this 25th day of October A, D, 1919, by the
circuit Court, for frederick County, Sitting as a Court of Equity and by the Authority
thereof adjudged, Ordered and decreed, that Maude M. Halley the mother of the said infant
Defendants, in this Cause to Wit- Edward M. Halley Jr., David M. Halley, and Frank M. Halley,
be and she is hereby appointed Guardian of the said infants, until the said infants Shall
have severally arrived at the age of Twenty-One years, And it is further adjudged, and
ordered, that the said Maude M. Halley before entering upon the duties imposed upon her
as the Guardian aforesaid, shall file her Bond, as such Guardian of said infants aforesaid,
with such sureties as may be approved by the Court, in the sum of \$5000.00. or if a surety
company bond is given for the same the sum shall be Three Thousand, and conditioned for the faith
ful performance, of her duties as such Guardian, and from time to time shall file and acco
unt, in This cause showing the investment if any and all funds to which the said infants,
Edward M. Halley Jr. David A. Halley, and Frank M. Halley, may be entitled and the dispo
sition made of the income, and profits arising therefrom to which said infants, may be resp
ectively entitled,
