it is therefore accordingly adjudged, Ordered and Decreed, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, Sitting as Court of Equity, and by the Authority, thereof, this 16th day Of April in the year 1920, that the contract of sale of the said real estate, and property mentioned in this Cause, as constituted by the offer of Charles R, Harper, of \$6200,00, and the acceptance of the same. by the parties, to this cause, as per the Supplemental petition, filed in this cause, of date March 10th, 1920, be and the same is hereby confirmed and that George A, Pearre, jr. and R, Bruce Murdock, be and they are hereby appointed Trustees, to convey to said purchaser, all the right, title and interest of all the parties, to this Cause, in and to said real estate, and Property, by a good and sufficient deed upon the payment by the said purchaser, of the full purchase price, of \$6200,00 to the said Trustee, which said Purchase price, shall be paid, in full on or before May.1st, 1920, that before said Trustees hereby appointed shall proceed to act they shall file with the Clerk of this Court a Bond in the usual form in the penalty of \$12500,00. with surety or sureties, to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, or in the penalty, of \$7000,00 as a surety Company, bond be filed, which said Bond shall likewise be approved by the Court or the Clerk thereof. conditioned upon the faithful performance of the trust hereby reposed, and the said Edith M. walker et al., are hereby Ordered and directed to return to William H, Hogarth the sum of \$500,00 deposited by him under his agreement to purchase the said real estate, made subject to the ratification of this Court.
