WITNESSETH;- that for and consideration of Thirty Six Dollars and twelve and a half cents, paid in hand the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, i,The said, Henry Stauffer, doth grant in fee simple, unto Josiah, Burrier, of the said County, and State all the following parcel of land, called " The Resurvey on Mackleys Luck," lying and being in Mt Pleasant District frederick County, Maryland, and included within the Following metes and bounds, Beginning for the same at a stone planted at the end of thefourth line, of Benjamins Delight, and running thence, S, 19° W, 28 perches to a stone, S, 62 1/2 ° E,33 -24/100. perches to the line of the said Josiah Burrier thence E, 63 1/2 °W; 20- 8/10 perches to the Beginning, containing One acre 3 roods and nine square perches of land, more or less, and part of the same land which was conveyed, to thesaid Henry Stauffer by Christian Winebrenner and others by deed, dated, on the 28th day of March 1877, and also by H.
