To The Honorable, Judges of Said Court;-

The Bill of Complaint, of G. Marion Hann, olive C, Whitmore, Elroy C, Whitmore, Levi Hann, John D, Hann, Lola I. Hann, Delila V, Hann, Mary M, Hann, and Paul A, Hann, respectfully represents,

1.- That a certain Julia E, Hann, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, was in her life-time, and at the time of her death, seized and possessed, of certain real estate, in the village of Treagerstown, Frdederick County, Maryland, Known as Lot No 80, in said Village, and more Particularly described in a deed from Mary A, Cppersmith, to the said Julia E, Hann, dated August 8, 1878, and recorded in Liber T,G, No, 11, folio 220, one of the Land records of Frederick County, and a Certified Copy of said deed is filed herewith as part, of this Bill, of Complaint, and Marked Exhibit A,.

3- That said Ruth Stull departed this life, intestate, on or about March 7th, 1913 leaving a surviving husband, the said Millard F, Stull, and three infant children, Viz; Norvall Stull, aged 9 years, Kenneth Stull aged 7 years, and Wilson Stull aged 5 years all residents of Frederick County, Maryland,

4- That the Other defclendants, Isaac L, Hankey, Souther Label and box Company, Swindel Brothers and George B, McClerry are Judgment creditors, of Paul A, Hann, and others, owning and undivided interest in said real estate,
