Coppersmith of frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth; that for and in consideration of One Hundred and Twenty eight Dollars, also further consideration set forth, in an Article of Agreement between Mary A. Coppersmith, and Julia E. Hann, and George W. Hann, dated the Twenty first day of February 1878, I do grant and convey in fee Simple to the said Julia E. Hann, of the aforesaid County, and state, the following described property, Viz; A house and lot, situated in the Town of Creagerstown, Frederick County, it being the same property which was conveyed to Mary A. Coppersmith, by Michael F. Eichelberger, Trustee, by deed bearing date, and recorded in Liber B, S, P, no, 6, Folio 469, one of the land Records of Frederick County, reference thereto will fully and at large appear,
