Bill of Complaint.

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT;:-

Your Orator who sues as well for himself, as for all other Creditors, of Georgiana Ashby, late of Frederick County, deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expense of this Suit, Complaining say;:-

(1) That the said Georgiana Ashby, was, in her life-time, indebted unto Dr, William G, Mocomas, of Frederick County, Maryland, in the full and just sum of \$57.75, on account of Professional services, rendered her during her last illness, which said Claim has been duly paid in full by your Orator, upon assignment, to him of the same, That the estate of the said Georgianna Ashby is indebted unto your Orator in the full and just sum of \$100.00 Account of her funeral expenses, paid by him, which said accounts are filed herewith marked Exhibits, A, which said Exhibits, together with all other Exhibits, herewith filed, it is prayed, may be taken and accepted as a part of this Bill of Complaint.

(2) That the said Georgianna Ashby being so indebted as aforesaid, and also being indebted unto divers other persons in various, sums of Money, and having real estate of value departed this life on or about the 3rd day of June, in the year A,D, 1917, in said County intestate,

(3) That Robert Ashby, the husband of said Georgiana Ashby, being so seized in his life time, in fee simple, of a certain Lot, or parcel of ground, situate on the East side of Klineharts Alley, in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, and fronting on said alley thirty feet more or less, for depth forty six feet more or less, and fully described in a Deed from William H, Hinks, Trustee to the said Robert ashby, dated the 5th day of July in the year 1890, and recorded in Liber J, L, J, No, 11- folio 194, one of the Land records of Frederick County, which deed is filed herewith as Exhibit B,

(4) That the said Robert Ashby departed this life in the Year A,D, 1900, in said County, and State, intestate, leaving as his sole and Only Heir, his said wife, Georgianna
