JULIANN L. WATKINS, a Witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the Plaintiffs being first duly sworn and Examined Viva-Voce, deposes and says as follows;-

My Name is Juliann L. Watkins, I am the wife of Noah Watkins, & am one of the Plaintiffs in these proceedings, I knew all the Parties to this cause,

John H. S Linthicum was my Father, and he lived on a small farm in the Neighborhood of sugar Leaf Mountain, during his life time, He acquired this property by two deeds, The one from Samuel Simmons and wife, bearing date the 9th day of August, 1852, and recorded in Liber E,S, No,I, folio 372, conveying 113 Acres, 2 rods, and 17 Square perches, The Second Deed was from Samuel^S Simmons, bearing date the 28th day of December A.D. 1858, which is recorded in Liber B,G,F, No,4. folio 164, and conveys 37 acres and 36 square perches, I look at Exhibit A, and B, which are now handed me, and they correctly describe the property mentioned in this proceeding, During the lifetime of my father he sold off from the property, he acquired by the two deeds i have just mentioned, a tract containing about 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, This was deed to William H,D,Simmons, by a deed bearing date the 22nd day of October 1878, and recorded in Liber T,G, No,10, folio 349, I look at Exhibit C, which is now handed me, it is a certified Copy of this Deed, I have just mentioned and it correctly describes the property conveyed, by my Father, during his life time, to Mr Simmons,

My Father died about the year 1896, and left a last will and Testament, which is dated the 17th day of August. 1892, I look at Exhibit D, which is handed to me, it is a certified Copy of the will of my father, the Original of which filed in the Office of the register of Wills, for Frederick County, Hannah Frances Linthicum, the life-tenant, mentioned in said will, was my sister, who died several months ago, my Mother died before my father and he left surviving him the following Children and heirs at law,

My Sister Hannah Frances Linthicum, who, as I have just testified, died a few months ago,

Myself, a daughter my husband's name being Noah Watkins, and we live in Germantown, Montgomery County, Maryland,

My Brother, William T. Linthicum, who died some years ago leaving surviving no widow, but the following Children and heirs at law; Martha Moylan, a daughter, who intermarried with Daniel Moylan, and who lives at Ijamsville, Frederick County, Maryland, Charles F. Linthicum a son, whose wife's name is Sarah Linthicum, they live at Charlotte North Carolina, Wilbur S. Linthicum, a son whose wife's name is Clarie Linthicum, and who live at Miammsburg, in the State of Ohio, James Garrett Linthicum a son whose wife's name is Gertrude Linthicum, and who live at Ijamsville, Frederick County, Maryland, Warren Linthicum a son who has since died leaving surviving him a widow who has since Married, and whose name now is Ella O. Loeffler, and one son, Robert E. Linthicum, who was Twenty One Years of age, his last birth day, both of whom live in the City of Washington, District of Columbia, Herbert Linthicum a son whose wife's name is Laura Linthicum, and who live at Gambrill's, Maryland

My Brother Dr. James G. Linthicum who lived in Baltimore, city during his lifetime, but who died some years ago, leaving surviving him a son Dr. John Webster Linthicum whose wife's name is Rose Linthicum, and who live in the City of Baltimore.
