DEED,

At the request of Isaac Cronise the following Deed is recorded August 6th- 1878,

This Deed made this Sixth day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred and Seventy Eight, by me William J, Worman, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of Eleven Dollars and forty One cents, I the said William J, Worman do grant in fee simple unto Isaac Cronise the following described piece or parcel of land Lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, Beginning for the same as hereby intended to be conveyed at the Beginning of the 97 1/2 square perches of land, which I the said William J, Worman, purchased from Henry Gravenhorst & wife, on the thirteenth day of July A, D, 1878, and running thence with the lines of said parcel two courses South 60 degrees East 1-36/100 perches, South 13 1/2 degrees West 9-26/100 perches then North 8 1/4 West 1-28/100 perches to a stake, planted in the closing line of said parcel and thence with said line North-13 1/4 degrees, East 9-78/100 perches to the Place of Beginning Containing Twelve and Seventeen one hundredths square perches of land, And I the said William J, Worman do further covenant that I will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed,
