I, Georgianna McDonald, of Frederick City, in the State of Maryland, being in perfect health of body, and of sound mind, memory and understanding, considering the certainty of Death, and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world, when it shall please God to Call me hence, do therefore make this my last will and testament, in Manner and form following that is to say,

First and Principally. I Commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth, to be decently buried at the discretion of my executor hereinafter named, and after my debts and funeral expenses are paid,

I give and bequeath unto Mollie Danner of Springfield, Ohio, the sum of five Dollars,

2. I devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate after paying my executor, and all debts, all my estate both real and personal and mixed to my Friend Lewis B. Kehler,

And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint C. H. Eckstein, to be my Executor without Bond, of this my last will and Testament, revoking and Annulling all former wills by me heretofore made. ratifying this and none other, to be my last will and testament,
