The above Cause Standing ready for a hearing and being submitted, the Bill, Answer Exhibits, Testimony, and all Other proceedings were by the Court read and Considered, It is thereupon, this 30th, day of December, in the year Nineteen Hundred and nineteen by the Circuit Court, for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority, of said Court, adjudged, Ordered, and decreed, that the Land and premises, mentioned in these proceedings be sold, and that Edward S.
