2.- That the said Thomas M, Logue, died intestate, leaving surviving him, a Widow, since married, Victoria E, Myers, an adult, whose husbands name is Charles M, Myers, an adult Daughter, your petitioner, Ethel F, Grabill whose husbands name is Mehrle L, Grabill, Roy T. Logue, and an infant son age 20, years, an infant son age 10 years, being the heirs at law to whom said real estate descended, all residents of Frederick County, State of Maryland,

3. That said Defendants the said Victoria, E, Myers, and Charles M, Myers, her husband, adults were returned summoned, by the Sheriff, of Frederick County, on April 12th 1920, and have since filed their answers in said Cause, consenting to the sale of said real estate by a decree of your Honorable Court,
