3rd. I devise and hereby set forth, and Order that in case of the death or Marriage of My Wife Henrietta whichever may first occur after my decease, then my surviving Executor, or Executors, hereinafter named named or the survivor of them, shall proceed to sell my real and personal property above devised, to my wife, in trust, for the use of herself, and four single daughters, as a support, from the profits, thereof, of Whatever Kind, there may be existing at the time of my wifes Marriage or death, whichever may first occur, and divide the proceeds, of such sale as follows,

First; if my daughter Cora L, be living at the time of such sale, then one hundred dollars, out of the proceeds, of such sale, be set apart in connection, with and in addition to one equal share of the proceeds of such sale divided equally among my wife, and Children which may be living at the time of such sale, share and share alike, and invested by my Executors or the Survivors of them and the interest or income therefrom to be used for the maintenance and support, of My daughter, Cora L, if she is living at the time of such sale and I hereby direct & wish that first my wife, shall act as Guardian and care for and support my daughter, Cora L, and have the full use of said income, for that purpose, and after the death of said Cora L, to have out of said investment, forty dollars, per year each year she has so cared for and supported the said Cora L, in Addition to said income, or interest from said investment, and the balance if any equally divided Share and share alike among my surviving wife and Children at the death of Cora L, and in case of the death of my wife, before the death of the said Cora L, then I wish my Daughter Amelia F, to take charge of and care for and support my daughter Cora L, and receive therefrom the Income from from said Investment annually, and after the death of said Cora L, to receive Forty Dollars, out of said investment, fund for each and every year, she has so cared for and supported Said Cora L, in Addition to said income or interest, and the balance if any equally divided share and share alike, among my surviving Children, at the death of said Cora L, and then the (balance (after said One share, and said One hundred Dollars, shall have been taken from the proceeds, of such sale) said balance shall be equally divided, among my wife, and children or their lawful heirs that may be living at the time of such sale resulting from the Marriage or death of my said wife, whichever may first occur, as follows that is to say share and share alike, to my wife, Henrietta, R Davis, my sons Samuel E, Davis William A Davis, John J, Davis, and my daughter Ida M, Trail, Amelia F, Davis Fannie B, Davis, and Elmira K, Davis Share and Share Alike,

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my dear wife, Henrietta R, and my son Samuel E, Davis, jointly and survivor of them to be sole Executors, of this my last will and testament revoking and annulling all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and no other, to be my last will and testament,
