May it please Your Honors to grant unto your Orators the writ of Subpoena, directed to the said George M, Forrest, Harry M, Forrest, Mary M, Forrest, adults, and Wilbur r, Forrest, Elmer Forrest, Garland Forrest, Arlington Forrest, Carroll Forrest, Margaret Forrest, Evelyn Forrest, and Dorothy Forrest, Infants, and S,W, George, & Co., V, Kaplon, Company, Charles A, Carlisle and R,B,Wenner, all of Brunswick Frederick County, Maryland, Commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court, at some certain day to be named therein, and to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree, as may be passed therein,

This Deed made this 21st day of March in the year Nineteen Hundred and sixteen, by me Harry M, Forrest, (unmarried) of Frederick County, Maryland,

Witnesseth; That in Consideration of the sum of Five Dollars, and Other Considerations, I the said Harry M, Forrest, do hereby grant and convey unto Minnie Forrest, and during her natural life, and upon the death of the said Winnie Forrest, then unto Harry N, Forrest and Wilbur^R Forrest, as tenants in Common, in fee simple, all that lot of land, in Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, now and designated on the Plat W,W,Wenners Second Edition, to Brunswick, as lot No,8, in Block No,2, being the same lot of land, which was conveyed to the said Mary M, Forrest from the said Winnie Forrest, by deed dated June 24th, 1897, and recorded in Liber J,L,J, No,16, folio 328, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, to which reference is hereby made, together with, the improvements thereon and all rights ways and easements, thereto belonging, or appertaining,
