THE REPORT OF SALES of Jacob Rohrback and Robert Biggs, trustees appointed by a decree of this court in the above entitled case to make sale of certain real estate therein mentioned, respectfully represents;

THAT, After giving bond with security for the faithful performance of their trust, and after having complied with all the other prerequisites as required by law and the said decree, your trustees agreed to sell unto Henry W. Stull and Ruby M. Stull, his wife, all that part of the land mentioned in the above entitled case which is fully and particularly described as follows;

BEGINNING for the same at a stone planted on the east side of a small watercourse and at the end of the first line of a tract of land heretofore sold to James H. B.
