In the above entitled cause being at issue and notice having been given me by the Solicitor for the Plaintiff of their desire to take testimony therein I, Clayton O. Keedy one of the standing Examiners of said Court duly appointed, qualified and sworn, having assigned the first day of October, 1921, at my office in Frederick City, Maryland, as the time and place for taking the testimony in this cause, and having given due notice thereof to the parties concerned, did, at the appointed time and place proceeded to take the following testimony to wit:-

The Plaintiff filed with the Examiner as evidence Exhibit Nos. 1 & 2 which are herewith returned by the said Examiner.-

SPENCER E. STUP, a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn and examined visu voce deposes and says as follows:-

My name is Spencer E. Stup, my age is 46 years; I reside a Charlesville in Frederick County, Md, I knew John A. J. Zimmerman, the testator mentioned in these proceedings. He is dead and died many years ago.

I knew his daughter Lethy Ann O. Pearl she is also dead, having died a few months ago, she was the wife of Daniel B. Pearl. He is also dead, The said Lethy Ann O. Pearl left the following children:-

1. Celia J. Walker, wife of Wm. E. Walker, they live in Balto, City;-
2. Minnie M. Toulson, wife of Jno. W. Tolson, who live in Anne Arundel County;-
3. Franklin J. Pearl whose wives name is Jennie he lives in Frederick County, and his wife in Balto, City.:-
4. Osear L. Pearl who lives in Balto, City;-
5. Esty M. Kahline, the wife of M. Kahline of Anne Arundel County;-
6. Charles J. Pearl, who is unmarried and live in Frederick County;-
7. Lizzie M. Pearl, unmarried, living in Frederick County;-
8. She had a daughter Mattie who married John Grimes. She is now dead having died before her mother and left an only child Mattie Violet Grimes who is about 15 years of age and resides in Frederick County with her grandmother Mrs. Grimes, All the other children of Lethy Ann O. Pearl are over 21 years of age.

I know the house and 5 acres of ground mentioned in the Will of the said John A. J. Zimmerman, and surveyed by R. A. Rager and described in Exhibit No. 2 and being the property on which Mrs Pearl lived during her lifetime.
