DEED. "EXHIBIT NO. 2"

At the request of Elisha Swomley the following Deed was recorded
July 29th, 1858.

THIS INDENTURE, made this fourth day of February in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty two between Daniel Swomley and Eliza C. Swomley his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part and Elisha Swomley of the same County and State aforesaid of the other part;

WITNESSETH;- that for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand four hundred dollars current money, by the said Elisha Swomley to the said Daniel Swomley in hand paid (or secured to be paid) at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge, the said Daniel Swomley and Eliza his wife, have bargained & sold aliened and enfeoffed, and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell alien, enfeoff release convey and confirm unto the said Elisha Swomley, his heirs and assigns all of their the said Daniel Swomley Eliza C. Swomley's (his wife) right, title, interest, estate claim and demand whatsoever in and to all the following parts of tracts of land being and lying in Frederick County aforesaid, as follows;- to wit;-
part of the "Resurvey of Halls Choice" containing ninety eight acres more or less also one other part of the aforesaid "Resurvey on Halls Choice" containing eight acres and one quarter of an acre more or less also all that part of the "Resurvey of Halls Choice" situated as aforesaid in said County containing and laid out for Seven and a half acres
