DEED "EXHIBIT NO.6"

At the request of Elisha Swomley the following Deed was recorded July 1st, 1862.

THIS DEED made this 1st day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty two by Joel Hall and Lucinda Hall his wife, of the County of Frederick in the State of Maryland, WITNESSETH;- that in consideration of Fifty five dollars the said Joel Hall and Lucinda Hall his wife, do grant unto Elisha Swomley of the said County and State all the following described part of a tract of land lying in the said County, and being part of a tract called "Benjamins Luck" Beginning for the land now intended to be conveyed at the end of Sixty nine perches on the ninth line of the original tract called "Benjamins Luck" thence running with the lines of said Elisha Swomley's land allowing two and a half degrees for variation so as to suit former locations South fifty six degrees West ten perches to a stone, South Sixty one degrees West twenty-two perches North five perches south Seventy two degrees West Nineteen perches to a stone at the end of the twelfth line of the whole tract called "Benjamin's Luck" then North Sixty nine degrees East forty eight and a half perches to the place of beginning, containing five eighths of an acre of land more or less.
