

Terms of sale as prescribed by the decree;- One-half of the purchase money to be paid in cash on the day of sale or on the ratification thereof by the Court, the residue in six months, the purchaser or purchasers giving his, her or their note, with approved security and bearing interest from the day of sale, or all cash, at option of purchaser.
