Lot No. 7.- 158 X 55 feet, more or less, I give to my Son Parris Hammond during his life and then to his lawful heirs. Lot No. 8.- 158 X 55 feet, more or less, I give to my daughter Frances Bowie during her life, and then to her daughter Ann Maria Nelson during her life and then to her lawful heirs. Lot No. 9.- 158 X 55 feet, more or less, I give to my daughter Manzler Smith during her life and then to her daughter Stana Thompson during her life and then to her lawful heirs. That William Hammond, the husband, of the said Ann Maria, died in December 1920; The Bill further alleges that the said John Hammond never married and resides near the Fair Grounds in Frederick County, Maryland; that Helen Shamwell died in the Fall of the year 1904, leaving as her only heirs at law her father Lewis Shamwell and her mother Mary Shamwell, both of whom reside in Baltimore City, State of Maryland; That Ellen Hackey intermarried with John Hackey and they both reside at Mount Union in the State of Pennsylvania; that Rena Taylor is unmarried and resides in Baltimore City, Maryland; That Emma Stewart intermarried with George Stewart and they both reside in the Village of Centerville, Frederick County, Maryland; That Worthington Hammond intermarried with Annie Hammond, and departed this life in the year 1919, without children and survived by his widow and the said Annie Hammond who resides in the City of Washington, District of Columbia; That George Hammond is unmarried and resides in the City of Trenton, State of New Jersey; That Parris Hammond intermarried with Louise Hammond and they both reside in the City of Baltimore, Maryland; That Frances Bowie intermarried with Andrew Bowie and both reside in the village of Centerville aforesaid; Anna Maria Nelson intermarried with Bernard Russell, both of whom have departed this life leaving as their only heirs two infant children, Frances E. Russell aged eight years and Annia B. Russell aged six years, both of whom reside in said village of Centerville with their grand-mother the said Frances Bowie; That Manzler Smith intermarried with Grafton Smith who now resides in Chester County, State of Pennsylvania; that the said Manzler Smith resides in said Baltimore City; Stana Thompson, unmarried resides likewise in Baltimore city aforesaid; That Thomas Hammond who intermarried with Minnie Hammond departed this life in the year 1917, without children and survived by his widow who resides in said City of Washington.

The Bill further alleges that all the parties to this suit are adults except the said Frances E. Russell and Annie B. Russell, and all are residents of the State of Maryland except Grafton Smith, Ellen Hackey and John Hackey; Annie Hammond and Minnie Hammond; and George Hammond aforesaid who are non-residents of this State. The Bill then prays that the said real estate, or as much thereof as may be necessary, may be sold for the payment of the claim of the Plaintiff and the other unsatisfied creditors of the said Ann Maria Hammond, and for general relief. It also prays for Subpoenas against the resident defendants and for an order of publication against the non-residents.

It is thereupon this 7th day of April, A.D. 1921, ordered by the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity, that the Plaintiff by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks prior to the 7th day of May, 1921, give notice to the said Grafton Smith, Ellen Hackey, John Hackey, Annie Hammond, Minnie Hammond, and George Hammond, non-residents of the State of Maryland of the object and substance of this Bill and warning them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 23rd day of May, 1921, to show cause if any they have why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
