

Stafford and Mrs. Emily McTavish with a reversion therein to me said Nephew Alexander Simon McTavish Now I do hereby revoke and make void All those several devises so made by my said Will as above mentioned and in lieu thereof I do hereby give devise and bequeath All my said Land Estate and interest therein situate in the said Counties of Washington and Alleghaney and which I am now or in any way seized or possessed of or to which I may hereafter become entitled unto my sister Lady Stafford her heirs and assigns forever save and except as to one thousand Acres of Agricultural Land part of the said Estate in the Counties of Washington and Alleghaney the said quantity of land to be selected and set apart by my said Sister Lady Stafford from and out of the portion of those tracts of land which I have inherited from and which were purchased by my mother from William Carroll Esquire and which said one thousand acres of land I do hereby give and bequeath unto The Reverend George M. Burder, Abbet of Mount Saint Bernards Monastery near Loughborough in the County of Lincoln in England his executors administrators and assigns for the term of One Thousand years at the yearly rent of one cent per acre per annum with permission for the said George M. Burder to cut and sell the timber on the said Estate but the Minerals therein I hereby reserve to my sister Lady Stafford her heirs executors administrators and assigns absolutely with the power to dig for search and carry away the same with all liberties of ingress egress or regress in to from or out of my said Estate for that purpose I give and devise unto my sister The Duchess of Leeds her heirs and assigns forever One Thousand acres of land situated in the County of Bradford in the State of Pennsylvania in the United States of North America and as respects all the residue of my lands in Bradford County aforesaid which have illegally been contracted to be sold and which contracts I am advised are void by reason of my parents having only a life Estate therein and reversion thereof being in myself and my three sisters I do hereby devise all and every my estate and interest in the same Lands in Bradford County aforesaid in four equal portions save and except as aforesaid One of which I give devise and bequeath to each of my three sisters the said Duchess of Leeds, Lady Stafford and Mrs. Emily McTavish their respective heirs and assigns and as the fourth portion or residue thereof I give devise and bequeath the same to my first Cousin William Woodville The Elder of Baltimore in the said United States of North America his heirs and assigns forever I hereby revoke and make void the dispositions I have made in my said Will of my Baltimore and Ohio Railway Shares and my shares in the Baltimore and Washington Railroad in favor of my said Sisters or of any other persons and in lieu thereof I give and bequeath twenty five of the said Railway shares to my much esteemed Friend Count Jules deMenon absolutely for ever And the residue and remainder of the said shares I give and bequeath equally between my three sisters the said Duchess of Leeds, Lady Stafford and Mrs. Emily McTavish share and share alike I give and bequeath to my good and faithful Maid Barbara Anderson the amount of one years wages over and above the sum that may be due due to her for the same at the time of my deceased And also one Annuity or yearly Sum of Twenty five Punds to be paid to her and her assigns during the term of her natural life I give and bequeath unto my equally faithful Servant Henrietta Johnson who came from America and her assigns an Annuity or yearly sum of Twenty five Pounds to be paid to her and her assigns for and during the term of her natural life I give to the Duke of Leeds my full length Portrait of his Majesty King William the Fourth by Sir Martin Shee as a proof of my regard for him I give to the Duke of Wellington my Portrait of his Father by Sir Thomas Lawrence as a mark of my regard for him I beg Lord Stafford to accept after the death of my said Sister Lady Stafford my own Portrait by Sir Thomas Lawrence the same being a work as done by him of same value, and I give it to his Lordship in testimony of my esteem, I do hereby revoke and make and make void the appointment that I made by my said Will of my friend General George Stewart as being one of the Trustees of a portion of my property as therein mentioned and as one of the Executors of my said Will and in his place and stead I do hereby make and appoint my said Cousin William Woodville the Elder one of my Trustees (for that part of my property which I have left in trust) and Executors of my said will and in all other respects I confirm my said Will and the first Codicil thereto dated the third day of March One thousand eight hundred and fifty three.
