And whereas my children are entitled in their own right to certain estate under the Will <sup>my</sup> of mother Emily Mactavish deceased.

I hereby nominate my wife Marcella Mactavish as and for their Guardian and request that letters of Guardianship shall be granted to her.

And Lastly, I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Marcella Mactavish the Executrix of this my last Will and Testament .
