

own absolute discretion during his life all my paintings, pictures, portraits, furniture, all the rest of my silver plate of every kind, glass, china, ornaments jewelry and all other household goods and chattels of every kind and discretion.

Third, At the death of my brother, I give and bequeath the two portraits of my grandfather, John Fraser MacTavish to Caton MacTavish But if the said Caton MacTavish shall be dead at the time of the death of my brother, and if he shall leave no child or descendant of his then living then and in that event at the death of my brother, I give and bequeath the said two portraits to Anita, sister of the said Caton MacTavish.

Fourth, At the death of my brother, I give and bequeath the portraits of the Duke of Wellington and of the Marchioness of Wellesley both by Sir Thomas Lawrence, to the New York Metropolitan Museum of Art, to be kept as a part of its collection forever.

If the said Museum of Art shall not accept the said Portraits then and in that event at the death of my brother I give and bequeath the said two portraits to Bancroft Carroll.

Fifth; At the death of my brother I give and bequeath the portrait of Charles Carroll of Carrollton by Sir Joshua Reynolds, to Bancroft Carroll.

Sixth; At the death of my brother I give and bequeath all my other portraits to my cousin Caton MacTavish, and Bancroft Carroll son of Charles and Suzanne Carroll, to be equally divided between them by my executor, in his discretion.

Seventh. At the death of my brother I give and bequeath my gold presentation medal of Charles Carroll of Carrollton, and his silver dress sword, and the family papers, consisting of letters, marriage certificates of Charles Carroll of Carrollton and of his father Charles Carroll to Bancroft Carroll.

Eighth. At the death of my brother I give and bequeath the portrait ring of George IV. which was given by that King to Lord Wellesley, and by him to my father, and by him to my mother, who during her life gave it to me absolutely, to the New York Metropolitan Museum of Art.

If the said Museum of Art shall not accept the same, then and in that event at the death of my brother, I give and bequeath the said ring to Bancroft Carroll.

Ninth. At the death of my brother I give and bequeath the gold Scott medal, gold handle Scott Presentation sword, and all the silver ware which was my mother's, and the miniature of my grandmother Mrs Scott and my grand father, General Scott, to Archibald Gracie, whose mother was my mother's cousin.

Tenth. At the death of my brother I give and bequeath my other family miniature to Caton MacTavish and Bancroft Carroll, to be equally divided between them by my executor, in his discretion.

Eleventh. At the death of my brother I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of the household goods and chattels, which I have left to him for and during the term of his life in and by the second clause of my will to my cousins Caton MacTavish and Bancroft Carroll to be equally divided between them by my executor, in his discretion. . .

Twelfth. The residue of the property and estate which I inherited under the will of my grandmother, Emily Caton MacTavish, or which I now own or am in any manner entitled to under the said will or have derived therefrom I give devise and bequeath as follows.

I. I give and bequeath absolutely to the Little Sisters of the Poor in Baltimore Maryland the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00)

II. I give and bequeath absolutely to the Little Sisters of the Poor in Richmond Virginia the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00).

III. I give and bequeath absolutely to Mary Bergin the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

IV. I give and bequeath absolutely to Saint Joseph Passionist Retreat Baltimore County, Maryland the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) All the said bequests I hereby make and declare to be charges upon so much of the said estate and the property as consists of real estate.

V. All the rest and residue of the said property and estate mentioned in this Twelfth Clause of my Will I give devise and bequeath to my Trustees hereinafter named and appointed and to their successors in trust and special confidence, and to, for and upon the trusts and purposes following,
