TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF SAID COURT;-

The Petition of Ernest W. Burch respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court;-  
FIRST;- That on the 25th day of September, A.D. 1922, a certain Etta Allen, of Brunswick Frederick County, Maryland, executed her deed of trust conveying all of her property, both real and personal and mixed, of every character and description and wheresoever situate, to your Petitioner, in trust upon the terms stated in said deed of trust, a certified copy of which is herewith filed, marked "EXHIBIT "A" to this Petition.

SECOND;- That your Petitioner has accepted the trust created by said Deed of Trust.

THIRD;- That your Petitioner is advised that he is entitled to invoke the jurisdiction of your Honorable Court to advise, direct and guide your Petitioner in the administration of the trust created by said deed of trust, "Exhibit A".

To the end, therefore,

1. That your Honorable Court may assume jurisdiction of the trust created by said deed of trust, advise and direct your Petitioner in the administration of the same.
2. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

EXHIBIT "A"

This Deed of Trust and last Will and Testament, Made this 25th day of September, A.D. 1922, by me, Etta Allen, widow, of Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland.

WHEREAS, my husband, Charles A. Allen, has recently died intestate, leaving me as his widow and two infant children Mary Allen, born May 7, 1910 and Agnes Allen, born May 21st 1921, and as I want to conserve my estate for myself and said infant children, and have some expenses judiciously and economically and under the supervision of the Court for the comfortable support of myself and infant children, and that any of my estate remaining at my decease may be divided equally between my infant children, or distributed as specified herein, and for these reasons and the purposes hereinafter set forth, I desire to convey and assign all of my estate and property, real, personal and mixed, of every character and description, unto Ernest W. Burch, in trust, as herein specified;-

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INSTRUMENT WITNESSETH, That in consideration of the premises and of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, the said Etta Allen, do hereby grant and convey, bargain and sell, transfer and assign, in fee simple, unto the said Ernest W. Burch, as Trustee, in trust, nevertheless, all of my estate and property,
