I give and devise all of the above property and estate unto the persons and bodies corporate entitled and above named to receive them free from and clear of the payment of any collateral inheritance tax, or any other tax or charge upon the same, and I do hereby direct and authorize the Executors of this my last Will and Testament to pay out of my estate, or out of any residum after the payment of all the above items any collateral inheritance tax, or any and all other proper tax or charge made by Law upon said devises, bequeaths and legacies,-

I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my property and estate, and not hereinbefore otherwise disposed of, unto my first cousins, that is unto all the children of my uncles and aunts on both my Father's and Mother's side, who will be living and who will in person come forward and prove their kinship and identity within six months after my death, to be divided among them, if there then be any residum to divide, by my Executors hereinafter named, equally, share and share alike, and I desire there to include in this division in place of their parent the children of my first cousins who may be dead at the time any residum of my said estate may be divided and distributed under this clause of this my last Will and Testament,-

I hereby authorize, empower and direct my Executors hereinafter named to sell and dispose of all my real estate in Frederick County, Maryland, or wheresoever located, my personal property, stocks, bonds, mortgages, securities and all other investments, and of which I shall doe seixed and possessed and such as are not otherwise herein specifically devised and given and disposed of, at either public or private sale, as in their sole discretion will be more advantageous for my estate, and at such times and on such terms as in their sole discretion will be more advantageous for all purposes of carrying out the provisions of this my last Will and Testament,-

I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Abram Kemp Keefer and Jacon Rohrback, residents of Frederick City, Maryland, to be the sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all and every other Will and Testament and Codicil by me heretofore made, hereby ratifying and confirming this to be my last Will and Testament, and none other.

In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal to this my last Will and Testament on this twentieth day of May, in the year nineteen hundred and ten.

Whereas in my above and foregoing last Will and Testament dated May 20th, 1910, I gave and bequeathed unto Emma Worman, daughter of Mary Worman and William Worman, the sum of two thousand dollars I do hereby revoke said gift and bequest of two thousand dollars, and I do hereby give and bequeath the sum of two thousand dollars unto the "Evangelical Reformed Church of Frederick," a corporation located at Frederick, Maryland, of which at this time Rev. Henri L. G. Kieffer is Pastor, and the record of the incorporation of which body corporate is found recorded in "Church Record," folio 145 etc, one of the Church corporation records in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, said money to be used by the Consistory the governing body of said corporation for repairs and church purposes;- and
