

per annum, and have on deposit subject to check in the Frederick-Town Savings Institution, bearing interest at four per centum per annum, and have on deposit subject to check in the Frederick-Town Savings Institution the sum of \$6788.35, and have the said two promissory notes in amounts \$2000. and \$1200. made by the said Frank H. Despeaux and David F. Davis and their wives, and secured by a first mortgage lien on the real estate described in these proceedings; - all of the above named being the entire amount of the corpus of the trust fund in their hands as Trustees at this time.

4. That your Petitioners have not stated an account of their trust prior hereto, so that the same might receive supervision, and further action or Order of the Court concerning the further execution of their trust in the premises.

5. That it is the desire your Honors will allow unto your Petitioners a commission as allowed unto Trustees for their services in the sale of the real estate, the same being the whole of the trust real estate in their hands, and which your Petitioners believe was sold by them at a highly advantageous price to said trust estate, and that your Honors will also allow unto Jacob Rohrback, the Solicitor acting for said Trustees, a sum of money as a fee his legal services to said Trustees and in the preparation of all papers as Solicitor for said Trustees since January 1st, 1914, and especially in the matter of the sale of the real estate unto the purchasers thereof, in the year 1923, and unto the date of your Honors Order on this Petition.

6. That your Petitioners have in their hands at this time ready for investment the sum of \$ _____ the same being on deposit in The Frederick-Town Savings Institution, and your Petitioners have been offered an investment for said sum of money in a like amount of par value of the first trust lien bonds, the obligation of Hood College, a Corporation of the State of Maryland, located at Frederick, Maryland, the same being a part of an issue of \$300,000. first lien bonds secured by all the property of said Hood College, said bonds bearing 6% interest, and interest payable semi-annually, and which bonds your Petitioners believe to be a safe and profitable investment for said trust funds.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray your Honors for the following relief; -

1. That your Honors will authorize and direct your Petitioners as Trustees to invest the sum of \$ _____, in their hands as Trustees, in the purchase of first deed of trust bonds of Hood College of Frederick, Maryland, bearing six per cent interest, to be held by your Petitioners as a part of the corpus of said trust estate.

2. That your Honors will refer the papers in the case to the auditor of your Honorable Court to state an account, and to allow your Petitioners the usual chancery commissions, and also a fee to their Solicitor or Record.

3. And for such other and further relief to which your Petitioners may be entitled in the premises. And, as in duty bound, etc.
