This deed, made this 11th day of January A.D. 1881 by us Daniel Main and Laura V. Main his wife, Carlton H. Main and Charlette R. Main his wife, George W. Main, Richard Tidings and Mary E. Tidings his wife, John H. Harris and Lucinda C. Harris, his wife, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland,

WITNESSETH;- that in consideration of Three hundred and Fifty Dollars, we the said David Main and Laura V. Main his wife, Carlton H. Main and Charlette R. Main his wife, George W. Main, Richard Tidings and Mary E. Tidings his wife, and John H. Harris and Lucinda C. Harris his wife, heirs of Ann E. Main, deceased, do grant unto Daniel E. Stone, the following lots, or parcels of land, to-wit;- that parcel of land containing three acres two roods and nineteen square perches of land more or less, situated in Mount Pleasant District, Frederick County, Maryland, about one and a half miles East of Mount Pleasant on the North side of the Liberty Pike, it being the same tract of land conveyed to the said Ann E. Main deceased, by deed from Jerome Rippeon and Mary Ann Rippeon, his wife, bearing date 31st day of October A.D. 1868 which deed is duly recorded in Liber C.M. No. 2, folio 579 &c, one of the Land Records of Frederick County by reference whereto it will fully appear. Also that other parcel of land containing one acre of land more or less, situated in Mount Pleasant District, Frederick County, Maryland, and which adjoins on the Northwest side the parcel above first conveyed, it being the same parcel of land conveyed by deed to the said Ann E.
