I, Jacob Little, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland being in perfect health of body and of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God, to call me hence, do therefore make publish this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say; First and principally I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my Body to the earth to be decently buried at the direction of my Executors hereinafter named, and after my debts and funeral charges are paid, I devise and bequeath as follows;

I give and devise unto my daughter, Mary Catherine Little, the two story brick house and the lot of ground belonging to the same with all the appurtenances being the same in which I now reside situated in that part of the city of Frederick called Hallers-town to her the said Mary Catherine Little, her heirs and assigns forever.

I give and devise, unto my daughter Harriet Ann Kaufman, wife of Warner Kaufman, the two story brick house and lot of ground belonging to the same, with all the appurtenances and now in the occupancy of Joseph Davis, to her the said Harriet Ann Kaufman her heirs and assigns forever.
