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To the Honorable Judges of said Court;-

The Petition and Report of Sales of William M. Storm, Trustee of the Central Trust Company of Maryland, Trustee, Mortgagee of Bruce S. LeGore and Louise F. LeGore, his wife, respectfully represents unto your Honors;-

FIRST; That on the _____ day of October, 1922, a certain Bruce S. LeGore and Louise F. LeGore, his wife, executed their deed of Mortgage to the Central Trust Company of Maryland, a body corporate, Trustee of the Central Building & Loan Club to cover a loan of Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars from said Central Building & Loan Club, the said Bruce S. LeGore being a member of said Club, the original Mortgage is filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 1.

SECOND; That said Mortgage contained the provision that if the said Bruce S. LeGore and Louise F. LeGore should default in the payment of the weekly payments covenanted to be paid to the Central Building & Loan Club for a period of three months, then it was agreed in said Mortgage that the whole Mortgage debt should mature and become payable; that the said Bruce S. LeGore and Louise F. LeGore, his wife, did default in the payment of the said weekly payments for a period longer than three months, thereby authorizing a certain Emory L. Coblenz to sell said Mortgaged property for the purpose of paying said debt to the said Central Building & Loan Club and the said Emory L. Coblenz
