To the Honorable, The Judges of the said Court;---

The Petition and Report of Henry A. Hahn, Trustee as hereinafter stated, respectfully shows unto your Honors;---

1. That a certain Charles N. Hahn and Ida Hahn, his wife, on the 22nd, day of July, A.D. 1902, executed a Deed of Trust, conveying all of their interest in and to several large and valuable tracts of land, and a considerable amount of personal property consisting of shares of the Capital Stock of the Frederick City Packing Company, Bank, Stock, Horses, Mules, Wagons, Farming Implements and other property of great value, to your Petitioner, Henry A. Hahn, in trust, for certain uses and purposes as therein set forth, as will appear by reference to a certified copy of said Deed herewith filed and marked Exhibit # 1, which it is prayed may be taken as a part hereof, as if herein in words and figures set forth.

2. That under and by virtue of the terms of the said Deed your Petitioner had conveyed to him, in trust, an undivided 1/3 interest in four large and valuable tracts of land, situated in Frederick County, Maryland, 1/3 of the number of Shares of the Capital Stock of the Frederick City Packing Company, 1/3 interest in certain Shares of the Farmers & Mechanics National Bank of Frederick and other Stock, and 1/3 undivided interest in a large number of horses, mules, wagons and personal property used in the business of farming the farms herein referred to or for the business of the said Packing Company.
