Should all of the said children arrive at the age of twenty-one years and the said Ida Hahn be still living, then the said Trustee shall continue to pay the income thereof to the said Ida Hahn for her support during her life or so long as she remains unmarried, and upon her death the said estate to be equally divided among the four children of the said grantors, share and share alike, and should any of the said children be dead, then to the descendants of such child or children; and the Trustee herein is hereby given full and complete power at all times and under all circumstances and conditions to sell at either public or private sale the interests hereby and herein conveyed, both in the real and personal estate.

1. That acting under the powers conferred under the Deed of Trust executed and delivered to him by Charles N. Hahn and Ida A. Hahn, his wife, dated July 22nd in the year 1902, and recorded in Liber D. H. H.
