

Deed of Trust executed by the said Charles N. Hahn and Ida A. Hahn his wife, to the said Henry A. Hahn dated July 22nd, in the year 1902 and recorded in Liber D.H.H. No. 15 Folios 58 etc, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, and consisting of all the right, title and interest of the said Charles N. Hahn and Ida A. Hahn his wife, and being a one-third interest, in and to all that real estate situate, lying and being in Mount Pleasant District in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, and known as "The McMurray Farm" containing 312 acres 2 roods and 30 perches of land, and being the same real estate as described in the Deed from Wilbur H. Duvall and Lola M. Duvall his wife to Charles N. Hahn, Aaron Rosenstock and Jacob Rosenstock, dated November 12th in the year 1900, and recorded in Liber D.H.H. No. 7, folios 426 etc, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, and in and to all that real estate situate, lying and being in Mount Pleasant District in Frederick County, Maryland and known as "The Baugher Farm" containing 352 acres, 1 rood and 26 square perches of land, and being the same real estate as described in the deed from William J. Snyder and Margaret Snyder his wife, to Charles N. Hahn his wife, to Charles N. Hahn, Aaron Rosenstock and Jacob Rosenstock, dated January 4th, in the year 1900, and recorded in Liber D.H.H. Hahn, Aaron Rosenstock and Jacob Rosenstock, by certificate No. 4, also one-third 40 shares of the capital stock of The Frederick Packing Company, assigned and transferred by M. G. Levy, Administratrix of Charles V. S. Levy to Charles N. Hahn Aaron Rosenstock and Jacob Rosenstock, by certificate No. 5; - at and for the sum of twelve thousand and eight hundred (\$12804.07) and four dollars, and seven cents, current money; - and which sum of money we obligate ourselves to pay over said Trustee upon the ratification and confirmation of said sale by the Circuit Court for Frederick County Maryland, in Equity. We also agree to be at all costs of conveying, excepting any taxed costs in No. 7533 Equity.

This Deed made this 12th day of November in the year nineteen hundred, by us Wilbur H. Duvall and Lola M. Duvall, his wife, of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Twenty Thousand Five Hundred and Twenty-four Dollars and Sixty-nine cents the
