At the request of Charles N. Hahn, Aaron Rosenstock and Jacob Rosenstock the following Deed is received for record and recorded Jan. 4. 1900 at 3.40 O'clock P.M. Test; Douglass H. Hargett, Clerk.

This Deed made this 4th day of January in the year nineteen hundred by us Daniel P. Snyder and Margaret A. Snyder his wife of Frederick County, State of Maryland, Witnesseth, That in consideration of the sum of Three thousand and twenty dollars, we, the said Daniel P. Snyder and Margaret A. Snyder, his wife, do grant in fee simple unto Charles N. Hahn, Aaron Rosenstock and Jacob Rosenstock their heirs and assigns all that part or parcel of a tract of land situate, lying and being in Urbana District, Frederick County, Maryland and described as follows, that is to say, Being a part of a tract of land called "Altogether" Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at a marked Black Gum Tree standing at the end of the 3rd line of 151 a. 1 R- and 30 ps. part of said land called "altogether" conveyed by Daniel P. Snyder and wife to Hiram T. Cutsail by deed dated March 6th A.D. 1899 and recorded in Liber D.H.H.No.3 folio 418 one of the Land Records of Frederick County and running thence by and with the lines of the said Cutsails part (7) seven courses and distances to-wit; N. 50 1/2° E. 36 perches to a stake by the side of a post and rail fence, thence N. 74° E. 17 6/10 ps. to a stake at a fence post, N. 63° E. 58 8/10 ps. to a marked post, then N. 2 3/4° E. 22 ps. to a stake, thence N. 33 1/2° E. 30 3/4 ps. to a stake, thence S. 69 1/2° E. 52 15/100 ps. to a gate-post, thence N. 45 1/2° E. 62 6/10 ps. to the middle of the Frederick and Georgetown road (now the Urbana and Monocoy Turnpike road) thence by and with said road (2) two courses and distances to-wit, N. 30 1/4° W. 41 3/4 ps. N. 38° W. 18 ps. thence S. 57 1/2° W. 257 1/2 ps. thence S. 46 1/2° E. 56 3/10 ps. to the place of beginning containing eighty-seven acres and twenty-seven perches of land as will more fully appear by reference to the annexed Plat which is made a part hereof. The part hereby conveyed being a part of the same land conveyed to Daniel P. Snyder by deed dated January 23d A.D. 1879 from Margaret Cramer duly recorded in Liber T.G.No.12 folio 194, one of the Land Records of Frederick County as by reference thereto will more fully appear. And the said Daniel P. Snyder and Margaret A. Snyder, his wife covenant that they will warrant specially the property hereby granted and conveyed and that they will execute such further assurances of said land as may be requisite.
